

REGULAR SESSION

MAY 16, 2011

The Union County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Monday, May 16, 2011. The meeting was called to order at 9:00 AM with the following members present: Lois Monday, Bob Brown, Bob Jansen, Dennis Brown, and Ron Riley.

AGENDA: Motion by Monday and seconded by Dennis Brown to approve the Agenda. All voting aye, motion carried.

OPEN FORUM: Margaret Kneedler inquired about the schedule and time frame of repairs to her road as it is currently impassable. Sam Woods and Ron Neely informed the Board of Supervisors that they had both hit a sign that was bent over in the road causing minor damage to their vehicles. Dick Anderson and Greg Driskell inquired about the schedule and time frame of repairs for Dogwood Avenue. They were under the impression that it was included in a three year bonding program. Elaine Gordon voiced concerns regarding Osage Street and if this project was going to be done this year. Gordon also talked about a group of citizens concerned about high taxes, and asked why no time line was put on a letter to a former Supervisor.

SICOG: Tim Ostroski, Southern Iowa Council of Governments, updated the Board of Supervisors on the CDBG Grant Programs that had passed through the County last fiscal year.

ENGINEER: Steve Akes, County Engineer, presented and discussed the maintenance and activity report and speed limit signage. A rock agreement with Thad and Sandra Sickels was discussed. No motion was made at this time. More information is being gathered.

Rock Agreement with County Conservation: Motioned by Jansen and seconded by Bob Brown to approve the rock agreement with the County Conservation Department. After further discussion a motion was made by Dennis Brown and seconded by Monday to table the first motion until Conservation Director, Doug Jones, is scheduled on the Agenda with Akes for more discussion. All voting aye. Motion carried.

MINUTES: Motion by Bob Brown and seconded by Monday to approve the Minutes from the May 9, 2011 meeting. All voting aye, motion carried.

HANDWRITTEN CLAIMS: Motion by Monday and seconded by Dennis Brown to approve handwritten claims for Union County Health Insurance for \$20,690.19 and \$467.69. All voting aye. Motion carried.
