REGULAR SESSION

AUGUST 15, 2011

The Union County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Monday, August 15, 2011. The meeting was called to order at 9:00 AM with the following members present: Bob Jansen, Dennis Brown, Bob Brown, Lois Monday and Ron Riley.

AGENDA: Motion by Dennis Brown and seconded by Bob Brown to approve the Agenda. All voting aye. Motion carried.

MINUTES: Motion by Monday and seconded by Jansen to approve the minutes from August, 8 2011. All voting aye. Motion carried.

OPEN FORUM: Wayne Hill, Afton Star, updated the board on the Burma shave signs that have been put up, and have received positive feed-back. Hill would like to know how to establish a highway garbage pick-up group, and would like to see an effort to improve the Afton Lake area. Hill also expressed the need to fix the dam posts for safety reasons. Karon Finn expressed concern on not receiving a reply regarding the duties of the County Attorney. Finn would like Open Forum defined. Finn questioned funds coming out of the General Basic Fund vs. the Litigation Fund. Leslie Wurster asked about the status of the Cherry Street Road Project.

ENGINEER: Steve Akes, County Engineer, presented and discussed the maintenance activity report. Purchase of a Used Forklift from Federal Surplus Property, and equipment for a County Surplus Sale that will be scheduled at a later date. Utility Permit: Motion by Monday and seconded by Dennis Brown to approve the utility permit with Windstream in placing a (24) fiber optic communications cable and necessary pedestals by plowing and boring at a minimum depth of 36' approximately 26 ft off centerline of County Road H20 (110th Street) Green Valley Road (P27) and Spaulding Road. Utility **Permit:** Motion by Monday and seconded by Bob Brown to approve the utility permit with SIRWA to install a rural water line in Section 33 of Spaulding Township. All voting aye. Motion carried. **Utility Permit:** Motion by Jansen and seconded by Monday to approve the utility permit with Windstream in placing 120 feet of 12 pair copper telephone cable and new pedestal at 1396 Osage Street in Lincoln Township, Section 19 and 20. All voting aye. Motion carried. Pavement striping: Motion by Bob Brown and seconded by Monday to approve Vogel Traffic Services proposal for approximately \$33,237.55 for pavement striping. All voting aye. Motion carried.
