

REGULAR SESSION

November 14, 2011

The Union County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Monday, November 14, 2011. The meeting was called to order at 9:00 AM with the following members present: Bob Jansen, Dennis Brown, Bob Brown, Lois Monday and Ron Riley.

AGENDA: Motion by Dennis Brown and seconded by Bob Brown to approve the Agenda. All voting aye. Motion carried.

MINUTES: Motion by Monday and seconded by Bob Brown to approve the Minutes from November 7, 2011. All voting aye. Motion carried.

OPEN FORUM: Dick Anderson, Allen Higgins, Steve Wintermute, Calvin Huffman, and Brad Waltz discussed Dogwood Ave and the improvements that have been done. They feel that the job should not be acceptable by the Supervisors and feel that it won't last thru the winter.

CANVASS CITY ELECTION: Motion by Monday and seconded by Dennis Brown to approve the City Election Canvass. Roll call vote: Dennis Brown, aye; Bob Brown, aye; Monday, aye; Jansen, aye; Riley, aye. Motion carried.

VETERAN'S BOARD MEMBER: Motion by Monday and seconded by Bob Brown to approve Sharon Moffitt to serve on the Veteran Board Commission as per the recommendation of the Veteran Board member and presented by Gary O'Daniels. All voting aye, motion carried.

SUPERVISOR REDISTRICTING MAP: Motion by Bob Brown and seconded by Monday to approve the three member Board of Supervisor map. Roll call vote: Bob Brown, aye, Monday, aye; Jansen, nay; Dennis Brown, nay; Riley, aye; motion carried.

COUNTY HELD TAX ASSIGNMENT: Motion by Bob Brown and seconded by Monday to accept the assignment of the tax sale county held certificates of P101001 for \$ 42, P101002 for \$51, and P101003 for \$36 to Maple Grove Investments. All voting aye, motion carried.

MOBILE HOME TAX ABATEMENT RESOLUTION: Motion by Monday and seconded by Bob Brown to approve Resolution 11 as follows: **WHEREAS:** Chapter 435.25 of the Code of Iowa States, when a manufactured or mobile home is removed from the county where delinquent taxes are owed or when it is administratively impractical to pursue tax collection through the remedies of this section, all taxes, both regular and special, penalties, interest and cost shall be abated by resolution of the County Board of Supervisors: **WHEREAS:** said mobile homes that are located at 203 S Olive St, Afton Iowa; 210 S Grace St, Lot 12, Afton, Iowa; and 627 New York Ave, Lot 7 Creston, Iowa, has gone through the county Held tax Sale and the taxes are uncollectible. **NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:** The Union County Board of Supervisors are directing the Union County Treasurer to strike the taxes of a grand total of \$2,852.00 from the tax books on said mobile homes.
