The Union County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Wednesday, April 18, 2012. The meeting was called to order at 9:00 AM with the following members present: Bob Jansen, Lois Monday, Dennis Brown, Ron Riley and Bob Brown.

AGENDA: Motion by Jansen and seconded by Dennis Brown to approve the Agenda. All voting aye. Motion carried.

MINUTES: Motion by Monday and seconded by Riley to approve the April 9, 2012 minutes. All voting aye. Motion carried.
