March 11, 2013

The Union County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Monday, March 11 2013. The meeting was called to order at 9:00 AM with the following members present: Dennis Brown, Lois Monday and Ron Riley.

AGENDA: Motion by Monday and seconded by Brown to approve the Agenda. All voting aye, motion carried.

MINUTES: Motion by Monday and seconded by Brown to approve the minutes from March 4, 2013. All voting aye, motion carried.

OPEN FORUM: Wayne Hill commented on next year's budget and had a few questions on the expenses.

ENGINEER: Steve Akes, County Engineer, presented and discussed the maintenance activity report. Motion by Brown and seconded by Monday to approve the **2013 Real Estate Acquisition Policy Resolution # 24** WHEREAS on the 11TH day of March 2013 the Union County Board of Supervisors has established a new Real Estate Acquisition Policy for the year of 2013 REAL ESTATE The current average assessed valuation of real estate in Union County is \$796.00 per acre. Current market value of real estate in Union County is \$3708.00 per acre \$3708.00 \$796.00 = 4.66 Our factor of 4.66 was the assessed evaluation for the true selling price for bare land in Union County with a factor of 1.5 times the assessed valuation for acquisition of real estate for borrow projects. Fencing based upon a recent quotation, a barb wire fence would cost \$35.31 & \$36.22 to construct. Recommendation of \$36.25 per rod for barb wire and \$50.00 per rod for woven wire fence. In addition, each owner is entitled to an additional \$125.00 per interior corner that he/she is required to build of irregularities in the right-of-way purchase lines. Roll Call Vote: Brown, aye. CARE: Jana Daily, CARE, discussed routine business and repairs needed to the CARE Facility, also discussed the Lease and Management Agreements. **Sprinkler System:** Motion by Brown and seconded by Monday for the chair to sign a contract with Continental Fire Sprinkler to replace an air compressor in the A Unit for \$1,737.00. All voting aye. Motion carried.

PUBLIC FUNDING RESOLUTION #25: Motion by Brown and seconded by Monday to approve RESOLUTION #25 NOW on this 11th day of March 2013, the matter of a Resolution approving Public purpose for expenditure of funds. WHEREAS Union County of Creston Iowa has adopted its 2013-2014 Annual Budget March 4, 2013, and WHEREAS, the Attorney General believes it is necessary to state a public use for the expenditure or transfer of funds to private groups, and BE AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED, that Union County of Creston Iowa believes it is in the public interest to contribute funds to the following: Union County Public Funding Council for \$19,058.00. Expenditure of funds by this organization will enhance the community and add to economic well-being by increasing jobs and attracting people to the environments of Union County. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Union County will require periodic reports from the organization of how funds were spent to enhance the community's economic well-being. Distribution of these funds will be subject to request and approval by the Union County Board of Supervisors. This resolution is effective the 11th day of March, 2013. Roll Call Vote: Brown, aye. SICOG RESOLUTION #26: Motion by Monday and seconded by Brown to approve the Resolution #26. This is a Resolution to participate in the planning and development programs of the southern Iowa Council of Governments. Whereas the Economic Development Administration was assigned to administer the provisions of the Public Works and Economic Development Act of 1965; and Whereas the Southern Iowa Council of Governments has been designated by the Economic Development Administration as an Economic Development District and Whereas the State of Iowa and the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development has designated the Southern Iowa Council of Governments as the area wide planning organization, and Whereas Union County is an active member of the Southern Iowa Council of Governments and participates in formulation of area wide plans and programs, Be It Therefore Resolved by the UNION COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS that Union County desires to participate in the fiscal year 2014 planning and economic development programs of the Southern Iowa Council of Governments in Iowa Planning Area XIV, consisting of Adair, Adams, Clarke, Decatur, Madison, Ringgold, Taylor, and Union Counties.
