Permission is hereby granted to the Nightlighter Fireworks Inc. to produce a fireworks display at 2921 Hwy 34, Thayer, Iowa 50254 of Union County, State of Iowa, to be shown on July 13, 2013 with a rain date of July 14, 2013. The occasion is for a private showing. The competent person authorized to conduct the display is Heather and Travis Messer, a PGI certified member in good standing of the Pyrotechnics Guild International, Inc. Duly licensed by the United States Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms and Explosives Agency under license #5-IA-175-50-9E-00120. A certificate of insurance has been provided for public liability and property damage including spectator coverage in the amount of \$10,000,000.00 with two weeks of the display. This display shall be supervised by volunteer fire & emergency medical services. This permit for a professionally supervised display of fireworks is granted on the 8th day of July, 2013.
