New Contracts for 2014 and 2015 Bridge Ratings: Motion by Brown and seconded by Monday for the chair to sign the New Contracts for 2014 and 2015 Bridge Rating with Calhoun-Burns and Associates Inc. All voting aye, motion carried. Parking Resolution: Motion by Monday and seconded by Brown to approve Resolution #3 for FY 2013-2014 as follows: On South Cherry Street beginning at the intersection of 185<sup>th</sup> Street and continuing south to the entrance of the Creston Municipal Airport. BE AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the sum of \$14,950 is ordered to be transferred from the Conservation Land Acquisition Trust Fund to the Conservation Capital Project Fund, effective this 9<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2013.
