

REGULAR SESSION

September 23, 2013

The Union County Board of Supervisors met in regular session on Monday, September 23, 2013. The meeting was called to order at 9:00 AM with the following members present: Dennis Brown, Lois Monday, and Ron Riley.

AGENDA: Motion by Monday and seconded by Brown to approve the Agenda. All voting aye, motion carried.

MINUTES: Motion by Brown and seconded by Monday to approve September 16, 2013 meeting minutes. All voting aye, motion carried.

OPEN FORUM: Karon Finn spoke in open forum about violations made on a manure spill in Union County that she had found out through CCI. Teri Queck-Matzie reported that if it was a severe spill the DNR would have notified the Creston Radio Station.

INTERVENTION AND ADVOCACY CENTER: Johna Sullivan, Executive Director and Kacey Barrow, DART/SART Coordinator, of Crisis Intervention and Advocacy Center, discussed what they are going to offer in Union County. Sullivan and Barrow are currently looking for a main office in Union County to assist the ten county regions for Adair, Adams, Clarke, Dallas, Decatur, Guthrie, Madison, Ringgold, Taylor, and Union.

ENGINEER: Steve Akes, Union County Engineer, presented and discussed the weekly maintenance activity report and the Bridge Replacement Program. **Water Line Crossing:** Motion by Brown and seconded by Monday to approve a water line crossing for Robert Brown located near the center of Section 5, Jones Township, 1704 Mt. Pisgah Road, Thayer in accordance with the specifications established by the County Engineer. All voting aye, motion carried. **Temporary Road Closing:** Motion by Monday and seconded by Brown to approve resolution #5 for FY 2013-2014. WHEREAS, the Union County Board of Supervisors is empowered under authority of the Iowa Code to temporarily close a roadway, and WHEREAS, the City of Afton has requested a short term closure on the extension of East Grand Street for the purpose of holding a running event in conjunction with a citywide celebration, NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE UNION COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS that East Grand Street extended from the East corporation line of Afton to High School Drive will be closed beginning at approximately 9:00 AM on October 19, 2013 and it will be reopened at approximately 10:00 AM or when the running event has been completed. Roll call vote; Monday aye, Brown aye, and Riley aye, motion carried.
