

Regular Session

March 30, 2020

The Union County Board of Supervisors met in Regular Session on Monday March 30, 2020. The meeting was called to order at 9:00 AM with the following members present: Ron Riley, Rick Friday and Dennis Brown.

AGENDA: Motion by Riley and seconded by Brown to amend the Agenda to include Jo Duckworth, Emergency Management Coordinator to give an update on the COVID19 situation. All voting aye, motion carried.

MINUTES: Motion by Brown seconded by Riley to approve the Minutes from March 23, 2020. All voting aye, motion carried.

OPEN FORUM: An oral comment was brought to open forum from Roger Vicker. Vicker was wondering if there would be a road agreement after completion of a wind turbine project.

EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT: Jo Duckworth, Emergency Management Coordinator, informed the Board of Supervisors that Union County did receive some PPE from the State. There are currently no positive COVID19 cases in Union County, but we should expect that to change. Duckworth would like to get the word out that social distancing is the first line of defense in the fight against this pandemic.

ENGINEER (VIA PHONE CONFERENCE): Zach Gunsolley, Union County Engineer, presented and discussed the weekly maintenance activity. **NRCS EWP Landowner Agreement:** Motioned by Riley and seconded by Brown to approve the NRCS EWP landowner agreement with Hayes Family Farms on Wolf Creek Drive in Section 31 New Hope Township. All voting aye, motion carried.

DEPUTY AUDITOR: Tandy Steele, Union County Deputy Auditor, presented Township resignations and appointments. Motioned by Brown and seconded Riley to accept the resignations with regret of Ray McNaught (New Hope Township Trustee), John Waltersdorf (Highland Township Trustee) and Blythe Waltersdorf (Highland Township Clerk). All voting aye, motion carried.

Motioned by Brown and seconded by Riley to appoint Scott Schultz as Township Trustee for Highland Township and Kelly Schultz as Highland Township Clerk. All voting aye, motion carried.

HANDWRITTEN CLAIMS: Motion by Riley and seconded by Brown to approve handwritten claims for MATURA Head Start for \$483.00 and for Central Iowa Detention Center for \$900.00. All voting aye, motion carried.
