May 4, 2020

The Union County Board of Supervisors met in Regular Session on Monday May 4, 2020. The meeting was called to order at 9:00 AM with the following members present: Ron Riley, Rick Friday and Dennis Brown.

AGENDA: Motion by Riley and seconded by Brown to approve the Agenda. All voting aye, motion carried.

MINUTES: Motion by Brown seconded by Riley to approve the Minutes from April 27, 2020. All voting aye, motion carried.

OPEN FORUM: Elaine Gordon relayed to the board that they didn't have any issues with their internet services with the wind turbines. Joyce Clark, Vicki Paulus and Brandy Stephens through emails asked to consider a cap on the wind turbines in Union County.

EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY: JoAnne Duckworth, Emergency Management Agency Coordinator, gave updates on the COVID -19 situation. **Opening Courthouse Offices:** Consensus of the board and the elected officials is to keep the office closed and revisit again May 13th to discuss date of opening. ENGINEER: Union County Engineer, Zach Gunsolley, discussed the weekly maintenance activity report, contract maintenance work. **Vehicle Purchase:** Motion by Riley and seconded by Brown to purchase a 2020 Ford F150 4x4 crew cab pickup for \$33,351.00 (with no trade in) from Creston Automotive. All voting aye, motion carried. **Easement Purchase P-1:** Motion by Brown and seconded by Riley for the chair to sign the purchase easement agreement between Union County and Karla J Alford for Parcel 1-P for bridge project BROS-SWAP-CO-(88)-FE-88 170th Street in Section 11 of Union Township. All voting aye, motion carried. **Easement Purchase P-2:** Motion by Riley and seconded by Brown for the chair to sign the purchase easement agreement between Union County and Jim Wendl for Parcel 2-P for bridge project BROS-SWAP-CO-(88)-FE-88 on 170th Street of Section 2 of Union Township. All voting aye, motion carried.
