The Union County Board of Supervisors met in Regular Session on Monday October 19 2020. The meeting was called to order at 9:00 AM with the following members present: Dennis Brown, Ron Riley and Rick Friday.

AGENDA: Motion by Riley and seconded by Brown to approve and also amend the agenda to add a handwritten claim. All voting aye, motion carried.

MINUTES: Motion by Brown and seconded by Riley to approve the October 12, 2020 minutes. All voting aye, motion carried.

OPEN FORUM: No one spoke in open forum.

COVID-19 UPDATE: Robin Sevier, Union County Public Health Nurse, reported on COVID-19 in Union County and the surrounding Counties.

All voting aye, motion carried. **Comp Time:** Motion by Brown and seconded by Riley to approve the comp time bump up to 60 hr accumulation. All voting aye, motion carried.

CLERK'S REPORT: Motion by Brown and seconded by Riley to accept the Clerk's Report as presented by Union County Auditor, Sandy Hysell. All voting aye, motion carried.

Motion by Brown and seconded by Riley to approve the Homestead/Military; Disabled Vet Homestead; BPTC and Family Farm Credit Dis-Allowances. All voting aye, motion carried.
