ASSESSOR: Union County Assessor, Mindy Schaefer updated the Board on the 2024 Residential and AG Dwelling Reappraisal for Union County. Starting the week of July 4<sup>th</sup>, 2022, Vanguard will start going door to door for reappraisals, the reappraisal values are for 1/1/2024. Creston area will be first on Vanguard's list. In getting the word out to the residents of Creston, Schaefer will be mailing out letters, meeting with the City Council, publishing in the Creston News Advertiser, and on KSIB radio and posting information on the reappraisal on the Union County Website under the Assessor's page. Vanguard employees will be gathering the data for the reappraisal bearing identification and utilizing clearly marked vanguard vehicles. The rest of the residential and ag dwelling properties in Union County will be reappraised over the next twelve to eighteen months, upon the completion of the City of Creston portion.

**SECONDARY ROADS:** Union County Roads Superintendent, Al Hysell, presented and discussed the weekly maintenance activity report and the Level Road C Ordinance. **Skid Loader Quotes:** Motion by Friday and seconded by Riley to approve the quote from Star Equipment for a new Takeuchi TL 12v2 skid loader (including 3 buckets) for \$83,764.83. (once skid loader is purchased, the SICOG Grant will reimburse the County for \$39,000, making the total cost of the skid loader and buckets \$44,794.83). All voting aye, motion carried.
