

REGULAR SESSION

MARCH 27, 2023

The Union County Board of Supervisors met in Regular Session on Monday March 27, 2023. The meeting was called to order at 9:00AM with the following members present; Rick Friday, Dennis Hopkins and Dennis Brown.

AGENDA: Motion by Hopkins and seconded by Brown to approve the agenda. All voting aye, motion carried.

MINUTES: Motion by Brown and seconded by Hopkins to approve the minutes from March 20, 2023. All voting aye, motion carried.

OPEN FORUM: No one spoke in open forum.

COUNTY HEALTH INSURANCE: Kathryn Polson and Skip Lowe, North Risk Partners, presented and went through the County Health Insurance renewal for next fiscal year.

NEW EMPLOYEE HIRE – ENGINEER: Motion by Brown and seconded by Hopkins to hire Christian Boehmer as the Union County full time engineer, starting May 30th, 2023 at \$130,000 per year. All voting aye, motion carried.

ENGINEER: Al Hysell, Union County Roads Superintendent, presented and discussed the weekly maintenance activity report.

STERICYCLE-SHREDIT CONTRACT: Motion by Hopkins and seconded by Brown for the chair to sign the Stericycle-Shredit Contract for the HHS. All voting aye, motion carried.
