Reimbursement For Maintenance of Veterans' Graves

WHEREAS, the Union County Board of Supervisors (hereafter referred to as "Board") has adopted the Union County Veterans Affairs Ordinance No 21 and,

WHEREAS, the Union County Veterans Affairs Ordinance No 21 does not provide a policy on maintenance of graves (Iowa Code 35B.17) and,

WHEREAS, the Iowa Code 35B.17 was repealed by 2024 Acts, CH 1047 ss 11 and,

WHEREAS, the Board desires that the following policy be added to the Union County Veterans Affairs Ordinance No 21

Section 5 – Other Services Rendered:

- 3. Union County will not reimburse to any public or private entity the cost of maintenance of Veteran's graves if:
 - a. the cemetery is owned by or is the responsibility of another taxing body, such as a city or township, or if
 - b. the cemetery has perpetual care.


This policy is to be effective March 26, 2025
