ORDINANCE 11

An Ordinance Readopting the existing county code, Union County, Iowa:

Be It Enacted by the Board of Supervisors of Union County, Iowa:

Section 1. **Purpose**. Code of Iowa Section 331.302, subsection nine, requires that once every five years a County shall compile its code ordinances. This ordinance readopts ordinances already in effect.

Section 2. **Readoption of Current Code.** The following ordinances have been previously adopted and enacted into law and were duly published as the law provides. They are stated herein by number and subject matter and by the authority of the Union County Board of Supervisor comprise Union County Code of Ordinances:

- 1. General Relief Program, in its entirety.
- 2. Ordinance passage procedure, in its entirely.
- 3. Board of Health Rules and Regulations, in its entirely.
- 4. Unauthorized use of property, in its entirely.
- 5. Fees for Trustees acting as fence viewers, in its entirety.

Section 3. **Code of Ordinances**. Copies of the code as adopted herein shall be on file available for public inspection in the office of the County Auditor and at the following location: Union County Courthouse.

Section 4. **When Effective.** This ordinance shall be effective after its final passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.
