ORDINANCE 15

The Purpose of this ordinance is to control unauthorized use of property controlled by or in the possession of Union County, Iowa.

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for anyone to place, park, or leave any personal property on property controlled by or in the possession of union County in excess of twenty-four (24) hour period without the express permission of the Union County Board of Supervisors.

Section2. The property controlled by or in the possession of Union County includes, but is not limited to, all road right-of-ways.

Section3. Personal property controlled by or in the possession of Union County includes, but is not limited to, all road right-of-ways.

- Section 3. Personal property includes, but is not limited to the following:
 - A. Bales of hay or straw, crops, or grain:
 - B. Equipment and machinery of any nature, whether or not self-propelled: and
 - C. All livestock or animals of any kind.

Section 4. Penalties. Any person who violates any provision of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by fine not to exceed on hundred dollars (\$100.00) or by imprisonment in the Union County Jail for not more than thirty (30) days.

Each day a person is in violation of this ordinance shall constitute a separate and distinct offense.

Effective date for this ordinance is May 1, 1985.

Ordinance 15 Variance: 3. Motion by Conrad and seconded by Sammons to approve temporary variance for Veron Long on secondary road for hay elevator in county right-of-way while filling his barn located in Section 35 T72N R30W Highland Township. All voting aye. Motion carried.
