The Union County Board of Supervisors met in Regular Session on Wednesday December 31, 2025, at 9:00AM, with the following Board members present, Dennis Hopkins, Rick Friday and Dennis Brown.

AGENDA: Motion by Hopkins and seconded by Friday to approve the agenda. All voting aye, motion carried.

MINUTES: Motion by Friday and seconded by Hopkins to approve minutes from Wednesday, December 24, 2025. All voting aye, motion carried.

OPEN FORUM: No comments were made in open forum.

PUBLIC HEARING: Motion by Hopkins and seconded by Friday to open the public hearing at 9:05 on Ordinances #30-#43. No written and oral comments were received from the Auditor’s Office or from the Board of Supervisors. Public Hearing closed at 9:11. Motion by Friday and seconded by Hopkins to accept the first Reading of the Ordinances #30-#43. Roll call vote: Hopkins aye, Friday aye, Brown aye, motion carried.

RESOLUTION #10 FYR 25/26 – ORDINANCE #30-#43 REVIEW/WAIVE MULTIPLE READINGS/APPROVAL: Motion by Friday and seconded by Hopkins to approve Resolution #10 FYR 25/26 as follows: NOW on this 31st day of December 2025, the matter of waiver/suspension/adoption of the requirement of multiple readings of the proposed Ordinances #30, #31, #32, #33, #34, #35, #36, #38, #39, #39A #40, #42, #43 comes to the attention of the Union County Board of Supervisors. WHEREAS, the Union County Board of Supervisors has determined that Ordinance #30, #32, #38 and #39 Amendment has been duly published in two (2) official newspapers of Union County on as required by Iowa Code Sections 349.3(1), 331.305, and 331.302; and WHEREAS the Union County Board of supervisors has previously received and considered information regarding this ordinance, and WHEREAS, the Union County Board of Supervisors has held 1 public hearing, and no written or oral objections were received; oral comments were taken in consideration; and WHEREAS the Union County Board of Supervisors believes it is in the best interests of the citizens of Union County to adopt Ordinance #30, #32, #38 and #39 Amendment and re-adopt Ordinances #31, #34, #35. #38, #40, #42 and delete because no longer usable #33 and #39A and #43 without further delay; and BE AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that Union County, by and through the Union County Board of Supervisors, pursuant to the provisions of section 331.302(5) formally waives/suspends the requirement of multiple readings (2nd and 3rd Reading) of the proposed adoption of Ordinance #30, #32, #38 and #39 Amendment and re-adopt Ordinances #31, #34, #35, #38, #40 and #42 and delete Ordinance #33 and #39A and #43. Roll call vote: Hopkins aye, Friday aye, Brown aye, motion carried.

SHERIFF COMPENSATION BOARD REPRESENTATIVE: Motion by Friday and seconded by Hopkins to accept Drew Henderson as the Sheriff’s compensation board representative as presented by Union County Sheriff, Brian Bolton. All voting aye, motion carried.

SECONDARY ROADS: Al Hysell, Union County Roads Superintendent, presented and discussed the weekly maintenance activity report.
