APRIL 22, 2026

The Union County Board of Supervisors met in Regular Session on Wednesday, April 22nd, 2026, at 9:00AM, with the following Board members present, Dennis Brown, Dennis Hopkins, and Rick Friday. Present from the Creston Community Government Class were: Emma Crawford, Chaylee Needham, Raegan Kinsella, Trevar McClain, Ben Rushing and Mahi Patel.

AGENDA: Motion by Hopkins and seconded by Brown to approve the agenda. All voting aye, motion carried.

MINUTES: Motion by Brown and seconded by Hopkins to approve the minutes from April 15th, 2026, meeting. All voting aye, motion carried.

OPEN FORUM: No one spoke in open forum.

PUBLIC HEARING: Motion by Hopkins and seconded by Brown to open the public hearing for the Union County Fiscal Year 26/27 Budget at 9:05AM. Roll call vote: Hopkins aye, Brown aye, Friday aye, motion carried. HISTORICAL SOCIETY: Brian Zachery, Dick Anderson and Steve Francis from the Historical Village Society discussed a new museum that the society would like to build in the Union County Historical Village. They have been working on grants to help with the construction and request that the Board of Supervisors consider supporting the project with a contribution of \$25,000 beginning in fiscal year 27/28 and continuing in the following fiscal years. The Union County Historical Society has been in contact with the area schools and DNR in using the proposed new museum for educational purposes with the additional goal of attracting more tourism to the site.
